A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Cearning from the "Greats."

Luke 18:16-17 ¹⁶ But Jesus called the children to him and said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. ¹⁷ I tell you the truth, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it."

Hello Friends,

I refer to this passage often, but like many Scriptures, in different seasons, it speaks to me in different ways. This quality is part of why we refer to the Bible as the "Living" Word, this ability to be ancient, and unchanging and yet is adaptable and appropriate for countless seasons in our lives. Take this passage, for instance. Many times it is a favorite I have used to stress the importance of ministry to and for children in the church and

community. And, while that is true, it is also true that this passage is inviting followers of Christ to become "like" a little child. And while we can wax eloquently about the various qualities of children we should have, what I have not heard (or told) as often is how children teach us!!

There is an awe and wonder and a joy they see in the world around us that we sometimes don't. We bigger kids could stand to have a little more awe, wonder, and joy in our lives, and the more we are around

children, I think, the more we are able to experience these things. We are in the midst of, and continuing into, a marvelous season of ministry to, for, and with children (and those who teach them).

Lunch Bunch and Kids Club has been going strong, and the coming start of the school year leads to more ministry opportunities. Our Children's Ministry Director, Becky Garrett, is making preparations to add mentors for the one on one


Kids Hope program. Our number of small children has grown to a point that our fall Sunday School classroom assignments are going to have to adapt over the next few weeks. With 3 newborns having arrived, and 3 more on the way in the coming months, our nursery is pushing our potty trained young ones out, and the other age ranges are going to have to follow suit. Preparations are also being made for the School Prayer Walk, where we walk the school hallways, pray in each classroom, and the prayer teams leave a signed certificate for each of the teachers and staff members. The picture on this page is of Becky giving instructions to the prayer walkers in 2016.

I still remember being at the Milton Union Elementary School Open House, and my son was in his new homeroom classroom. I walked him over to the teacher's desk, and

showed him where she had proudly displayed the certificate left by one of the prayer teams. It was our particular team that had left the certificate, and I saw his eyes widen when he saw where he had signed his name on the certificate, that a few days earlier we had prayed in that classroom for the students and that teacher, and now it was his homeroom. I think that is when the School Prayer Walk became one of my favorite events of the year.

So whether you are a part of Kids Hope, the prayer walk, the teachers' luncheon, are one of our teachers on Sunday Morning, or are supporting these ministries with your prayers, my hope and prayer is that we will allow ourselves to learn from these giants in God's Kingdom.

Mission/Ministry Update

Kay Wagner and Beth Thoele presented on the Visitation Team. It was established in February 2006. At their highest there were 19 teams of 2 and their lowest 12, with 1 permanent sub. Chris Long and Kay Wagner have been members all 12 years. These days, hospital stays are short, and recovery times at home are quick, so the teams find themselves sending notes of encouragement and prayers more than visits. Thru the years 115 different people have been visited. They help those homebound with many different things, spanning from getting groceries to helping dispense medicine. The people who are being visited enjoy the contact and feel that connection with the church. They enjoy lunches and the goodies being brought. The visitation team is blessed as much as the teams bless those being visited. The teams take bulletins as well as the Daily Bread, this also helps with keeping them informed of the goings on at Hoffman Church. Look for the table at the ministry fair this fall to learn more about becoming a part of this fantastic ministry.

Financial Report

Richard Smith Finance Chairman, reported to the Administrative Board at its July meeting that he has observed that funding is down \$7,000 from this time last

year. This may be due in part to vacations. Please remember to make up for the missed Sunday offerings when possible.

Carol Storer reported that they have been preparing for staff evaluations. Also in preparation is the Safe Sanctuary yearly policy form overview.

Trustees Report

The air conditioning has been replaced. There have been window repairs, carpet bids as well as painting in various places throughout the church. As always the trustees are hard at work to keep us safe, comfortable and compliant.

Pastors Report

June average attendance was 156.

Pam noted that since inception there have been 66 of the three different brochures about domestic violence taken. Total meals served for the 1st four weeks of Lunch Bunch are 361 at Hoffman and 194 at Good Shepherd. Volunteer hours at Hoffman have been 158. Money for the remaining 2 weeks is \$1,040.20. Carry home bags with food for the time between the end of Lunch Bunch and the start of school are usually costing between \$800 and \$1,000, so there may have to be an adjustment of only giving one week of carry home bags instead of 2 weeks.

Becky is making preparations for a very large promotion class. It will involve the start of a new Sunday School class, which means the recruitment of new teachers. See Becky if there is interest in teaching our young ones.

Joseph has completed Confirmation Classes. Very big win for him. He worked tirelessly on the 4th of July float. Youth numbers are down this summer, not uncommon. Please pray for Joe and the youth as they prepare for another busy fall.


