


A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR About Time

Brothers and sisters, grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

How do you tell time?
We have our calendars, our favorite sports seasons, and community events that mark significant moments. Historically, the Church has had a particular way of passing and marking time through its own calendar. Sometimes this is referred to as the Church Calendar, the Church Year, or also by the related topic of the Lectionary, which is the table or schedule of Biblical passages assigned to be read each day.

The Church Year is organized around the two principal Christian feasts: Christmas and Easter, celebrating the two major moments of Christ's life - His birth, the Incarnation; and His redeeming death and resurrection.

The Church Year actually begins on the first Sunday of Advent, the four weeks leading up to Christ's Nativity/Birth. After Christmas are the "Twelve Days of Christmas," culminating with the Epiphany on January 6. Epiphany commemorates the visit of the Magi to Jesus, the first revelation of Jesus as the Christ to Gentiles. Several weeks follow the Epiphany based on the theme of revelation, Christ's glory and power being revealed through miracles and healing.

The season of Epiphany concludes when we begin Lent on Ash Wednesday. Lent is a 40-day journey of fasting, soul-searching prayer, and penitence as we prepare for Christ's death and resurrection. The season's length of 40 days is meant to mirror the 40 days Jesus spent being tested in the wilderness.

The highlight of the Christian Year culminates with Good Friday and Easter, the celebration of Christ's salvific death and resurrection. What follows is six weeks of Easter, reflecting Jesus' appearing to the disciples over a period of 40 days before His Ascension.

After the Ascension, we celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, followed by a long stretch referred to as "Ordinary Time." We are currently in the liturgical season of Ordinary Time, which will not end until we begin a new liturgical year on the first Sunday of Advent (December 3, 2023). This is reflective of the reality that most of our Christian life is lived in "ordinary" moments, following Christ in the light and strength of God's Spirit.

God's will for us as Christians is that we would be "conformed to the image of His Son" (Rom 8:29). God wants us to be more and more like Jesus, and we seek to surrender more and more areas of our lives to God's will being done, our being conformed to the Image of Christ. Doing this even in the way we tell time, immersing ourselves in the story of Jesus year after year after year, then, can only aid the process of becoming more Christlike as individuals and as a community.

I invite you, then, the next time you come to worship and hear the words, "Welcome to Hoffman Global Methodist Church. Today is the $\qquad$ -
Sunday after Pentecost," to recognize and appreciate the great Story we are living in: being conformed to Christ, by the great love of the Father, in the power of the Holy Spirit.
