A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Brothers and sisters in Christ,
Two months ago we began to explore the four disciplines we are lifting up as a community that help us grow in holiness of heart and life: weekly worship, daily devotion - reading Scripture and prayer, accountable discipleship, and service. We have discussed weekly worship and personal devotion so far; this month we will look at accountable discipleship.

At its heart and from its beginning, Methodism was a movement of accountable discipleship. This took the form of "class meetings" and "band meetings." The goal of these kinds of groups was "to watch over one another in love." They fostered the cultivation of holiness and growth in Christlikeness.

These groups were not so much focused on Christian content and acquiring information. Rather, they focused on the transformation of each person through the power of the Holy Spirit, present and active in these small gatherings of believers. Groups like this helped their participants realize how to bear one another's burdens, celebrate one another's joys, pray for one another and really know each other as brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ.

Historically, to be a Methodist meant to belong to a class meeting. One's membership in the Methodist church was linked to their participation in one of these groups. This meeting consisted of 6-12 persons, where each person shared the state of their relationship with Christ and received prayer and encouragement from the others present. As Methodism in America grew and became more "successful," class meetings were no

longer a requirement for membership and involvement in them declined. Many would point out that the declining of the Methodist movement was linked to the decline of the class meeting.

The band meeting was optional and was reserved for 3-5 people of the same gender and marital status. The focus of this group was to confess one's sins and receive prayer, encouragement, and correction from one's brothers or sisters. This kind of accountability can be quite frightening at first. We wonder, "What could happen to me if I have to face my friends each week and be honest about how I am *really* doing?" A better question to ask is, "What could happen to me if that kind of accountability is *not* present in my life?" Part of the power of a band meeting is to experience what it means to be fully known and fully loved – a tangible expression of the Gospel here and now through other Christians, the Body of Christ.

Last month we spoke about personal devotion. There are things we do personally, individually, to grow in the grace of God. Then, there are things we do *socially* or communally, with other believers. All of us need both pieces - personal and social holiness. We cannot become all that God has created and redeemed us to be without the Body of Christ and our being deeply involved in it.

I want to invite you to join us on at **7pm on Monday May 13** in the sanctuary. We will talk
about these groups – classes and bands - in more
detail and see how we can implement them in the
life of our church. Come curious and hungry for
more of God's transforming presence.
