

"I will build my church." - Matthew 16:18

Brothers and sisters in Christ,

Beginning Thursday, July 11, we will begin holding prayer meetings on Thursdays at 7a.m. I want to use the space available in this month's newsletter to urge you to come and pray. I know there is not a perfect day of the week or time of the day that will work for everyone, but if you can make it, then please do. In the weeks leading up to our first Sunday at Hoffman, I was reading through a book by Jim Cymbala's book, *Fresh Wind, Fresh Fire* impressed the idea of a weekly prayer meeting on my heart. My conviction is that God wants our church to be a "house of prayer," a place that hosts His presence.

If you are wondering what will occur, there are two answers: 1) we will pray; and 2) I have no idea.

First, when we say prayer meeting, we mean spending time in prayer - no other business or agenda but making space to spend time with the Lord and for Him to speak to us. That is why, secondly, I have no idea what will happen. We just do not know what God will say or do or call us to participate in. But we do know that we want God's answers and ideas rather than our own. God will bless what He initiates.

E.M. Bounds, a Methodist pastor in the late 19th, early 20th century once said this: "We are continually striving to create new methods, plans, and organizations to advance the church. We are ever working to provide and stimulate growth and efficiency for the gospel . . . The church is looking for better methods; God is looking for better men . . . What the church needs today is not more or better machinery, not new organizations or more novel method. She needs men whom the Holy Spirit can use - men of prayer, men mighty in prayer."

If we want God to move and be glorified through our church, it will not come from reading leadership books,

mapping out a 5-year plan with the niftiest strategies, or putting a trendy coffee bar in our narthex. Revival and renewal are not things we can manufacture. When we pray, we are surrendering, to be men and women the Holy Spirit can use. We are admitting to God that we do not have the answers to being the church He wants us to be, and we want His answers. And not only do we want His answers, but we want Him.

It is possible the first few meetings will feel a bit awkward, and that's okay. Attempting to still ourselves in God's presence can feel uncomfortable at first, especially when we are with other people. But we are all in it together, and we are praying to a God who is patient and want to spend time with us.

In Psalm 46:10, we are told, "Be still and know that I am God." On the one hand this is an instruction: Be still. On the other, it is a promise: When we still ourselves we will know the Lord. Stillness in His presence is an invitation to let Him work, to let Him be God, as we stop trying to be. Being still lets His love surround us, wrap around us, and be poured into our souls.

Let us pray for God to have His way in us, individually. Let us pray for God to have His way in our church, that His kingdom will come, and His will be done on earth as in heaven.

God, You are always on time. You will give what we need. Your mercy endures forever. Your love never runs out. Take our hearts and inflame them with the illuminating power of Your Holy Spirit. Set us on fire with the love of Christ, that the world may see us burning bright. Amen.


