A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

1 Corinthians 15:14 And if Christ has not been raised, then all our preaching is useless, and your faith is useless.

Brothers and sisters in Christ, I have been plodding (rather slowly) along through a novel titled *A Prayer for Owen Meany*, authored by John Irving. The story is narrated by John Wheelwright, recounting tales of growing up in New

Hampshire with his friend, the peculiar Owen Meany. Every now and then, the book jumps to the present, and in one of these episodes, Wheelwright shares his thoughts about Holy Week and Easter as an adult churchgoer:

"I find that Holy Week is draining; no matter how many times I have lived through his crucifixion, my anxiety about his resurrection is undiminished - I am terrified that, this year, it won't happen; that, that year, it didn't. Anyone can be sentimental about the Nativity; any fool can feel like a Christian at Christmas. But Easter is the main event; if you don't believe in the resurrection, you're not a believer."

The honest wrestling over the reality of resurrection ("I am terrified that, this year, it won't happen") gets to the heart of what we are approaching as we progress through Lent and approach the cross and the empty tomb. It matters whether resurrection is reality. Resurrection, speaking in a Christian-ly manner, is not a theory or fluffy spiritual idea or a metaphor for "rising above it." It entails a real body, with real scars (see John 20:19-20). If it is just a figure of speech or a symbol, then death still has the final word. As the Apostle Paul tells the Corinthians, "If our hope in Christ is only for this life, we are more to be pitied than anyone in the world" (1 Corinthians 15:19).

We are reminded that Christianity is so much more than a philosophy for getting along in the world, for moral improvement, or vague notions of happiness. It is rooted and founded on events in history, in a particular time and place. It involves people with names, eye colors, interesting habits, and families. The cross and resurrection of Jesus, if just ideas, might put us in a better mood from time to time, but

in the end will be worthless. If the cross and resurrection are real and have happened, however, then death is defeated. In the words of Frederick Buechner: "Resurrection means that the worst thing is never the last thing."

It all raises the question: if death has been defeated, what am I afraid of? What keeps me running scared and awake at night? And how might that change as I accept more and more fully that the tomb of Christ is empty?



May we say with the Apostle Paul: Death swallowed by triumphant Life!
Who got the last word, oh, Death?
Oh, Death, who's afraid of you now? (1 Corinthians 15:54-55, MSG)


