> Let us pray and think about how we could return the favor or pay it forward to someone. Who is someone in your life that you could make this kind of space for, ask about their life, and listen - not just to respond but to share God's love? Like many things in life, this takes practice, and we can

know until they know how much you care." So often, I have entered a conversation with something to prove, to show what I know. When another person is speaking to me, answering a question, I am not listening to their response. Rather, I am just thinking about what I will say. 
